

Say Bye Bye to Your Old Mattress and Box Spring!

Republic Services has teamed up with the Mattress Recycling Council's Bye Bye Mattress program to allow eligible residents of West Contra Costa County to drop off old, unwanted mattresses, box springs, or futons at NO CHARGE! Households in the following cities/communities are eligible to bring 3 items per month to be recycled: [Richmond](#), [Hercules](#), [Pinole](#), [San Pablo](#), [El Cerrito](#), [Bayview](#), [East Richmond Heights](#), [El Sobrante](#), [Montalvin Manor](#), [North Richmond](#), [Rollingwood](#), and [Tara Hills](#). Please bring proper identification, or a utility bill with the address of the household generating the items.

Location: Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Facility,

Hours: Wednesday – Saturday, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Only clean, whole mattresses and box springs will be accepted.

The following items will not be accepted:

- ✗ Parts of or partial mattresses and box springs
- ✗ Wet, damaged, or soiled mattresses
- ✗ Fold-out sofa beds or crib mattresses
- ✗ Water beds, car beds, air mattresses, sleeping bags, pillows, mattress toppers, or other furniture

Drop-off is not available to businesses, but mattresses may still be taken to the Golden Bear Transfer Station (1 Parr Blvd., Richmond) for a fee.
